TOP THINGS TO DO

- Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route** — Japan's most dramatic mountain crossing uses cable cars, buses, and ropeways to reach 2,450 m.
 - Toyama Castle Park** — A photogenic reconstruction of the feudal castle sits in a leafy central park, its moat fed by the Jinzu River earning...
 - Toyama Glass Art Museum** — Designed by Kengo Kuma, this striking timber-and-glass building hosts a permanent
- Dale Chihuly installation alongside...

 - Zuiryū-ji Zen Temple, Takaoka** — A National Treasure and one of Japan's finest Zen temple complexes, Zuiryū-ji is in nearby Takaoka (30 min from port)...
 - Iwase Historic Merchant District** — Edo and Meiji-period merchant houses line the streets of this former port district, once the hub of Toyama's medicine...

BEST WALKS

- Castle to Glass Museum Loop** 2.5 km · ~45 min · flat — From Toyama Station, walk to Toyama Castle Park (10 min), explore the grounds, then continue to the Glass Art Museum on the main...
- Fugan Canal Kansui Park Stroll** 1.5 km canal loop · 30 min · flat — A peaceful walk along the Fugan Canal with wide views of the Tateyama mountain range on clear days.

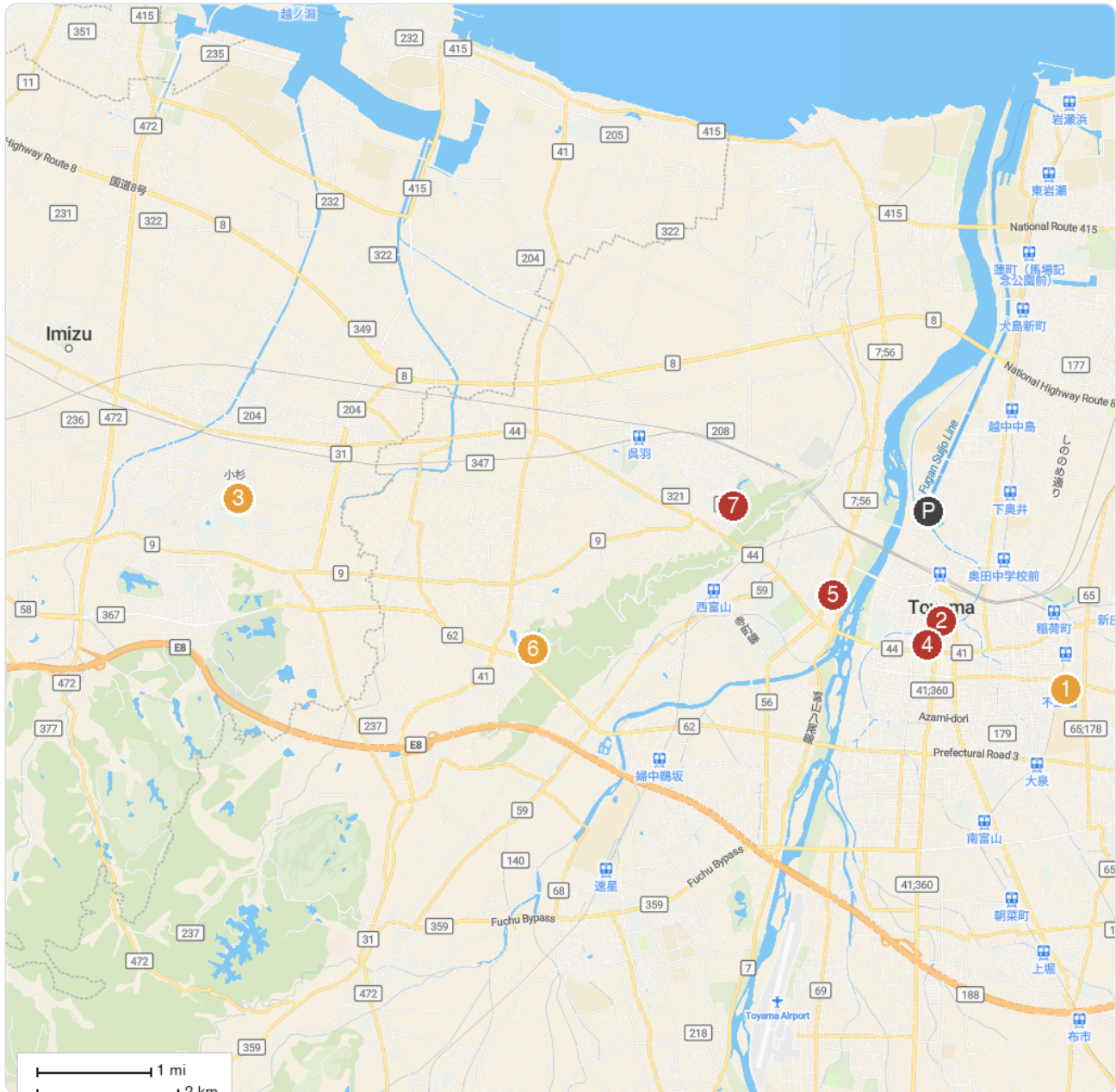
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book the Alpine Route early. Buses and cable cars have capacity limits — join a cruise-organised tour or pre-book online. Don't attempt it independently on a tight turnaround.
- Carry cash yen. Many smaller restaurants, temples, and tram stops are cash-only. ATMs at 7-Eleven and Japan Post accept foreign cards.
