

Traben-Trarbach, Moselle Valley, Germany

Once Europe's second-largest wine-trading city after Bordeaux, this twin town flaunts Art Nouveau mansions and 100km of underground cellars — all steps from the river.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River-docked alongside the Moselle promenade; max vessel 135 m, single berth

Best For: Riesling tastings, Art Nouveau architecture, underground cellar tours, castle hike

Walk to Center: 0–5 min from dock to either town center; bridge crossing to opposite side ~10 min

Don't Miss: The underground wine cellar tour (Unterwelt) and the Brückentor gate on the Trarbach side

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €6–11 (short town trips) ·  **Rideshare**  Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Underground Wine Cellar Tour (Unterwelt)** — Descend into the network of 19th-century vaulted cellars beneath the town, once holding millions of liters of Moselle...
- **Art Nouveau Architecture Walk** — Bruno Möhring's Belle Époque legacy is everywhere — the Brückentor gate, Romantik Hotel Bellevue, and Villa Huesgen are...
- **Hike to Grevenburg Castle Ruins** — A steep 20–30 minute zig-zag climb through the vineyards above the Trarbach side rewards you with spectacular panoramic...
- **Buddha Museum** — One of the world's largest collections of Buddha figures, housed inside a restored Art Nouveau winery designed by Bruno...
- **Riesling Tasting at a Local Weingut** — The steep slate-soil vineyards of the Moselle produce world-class Riesling.

BEST WALKS

- **Twin Town Stroll** 2.5 km · 45–60 min · Flat — Walk the Traben promenade, cross the Möhring-designed bridge (Brückentor gate on the Trarbach side), explore the Trarbach old town...
- **Vineyard Climb to Grevenburg Ruins** 3 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Strenuous — From the Trarbach waterfront, follow the vineyard trail steeply uphill to the ruined Grevenburg Castle.

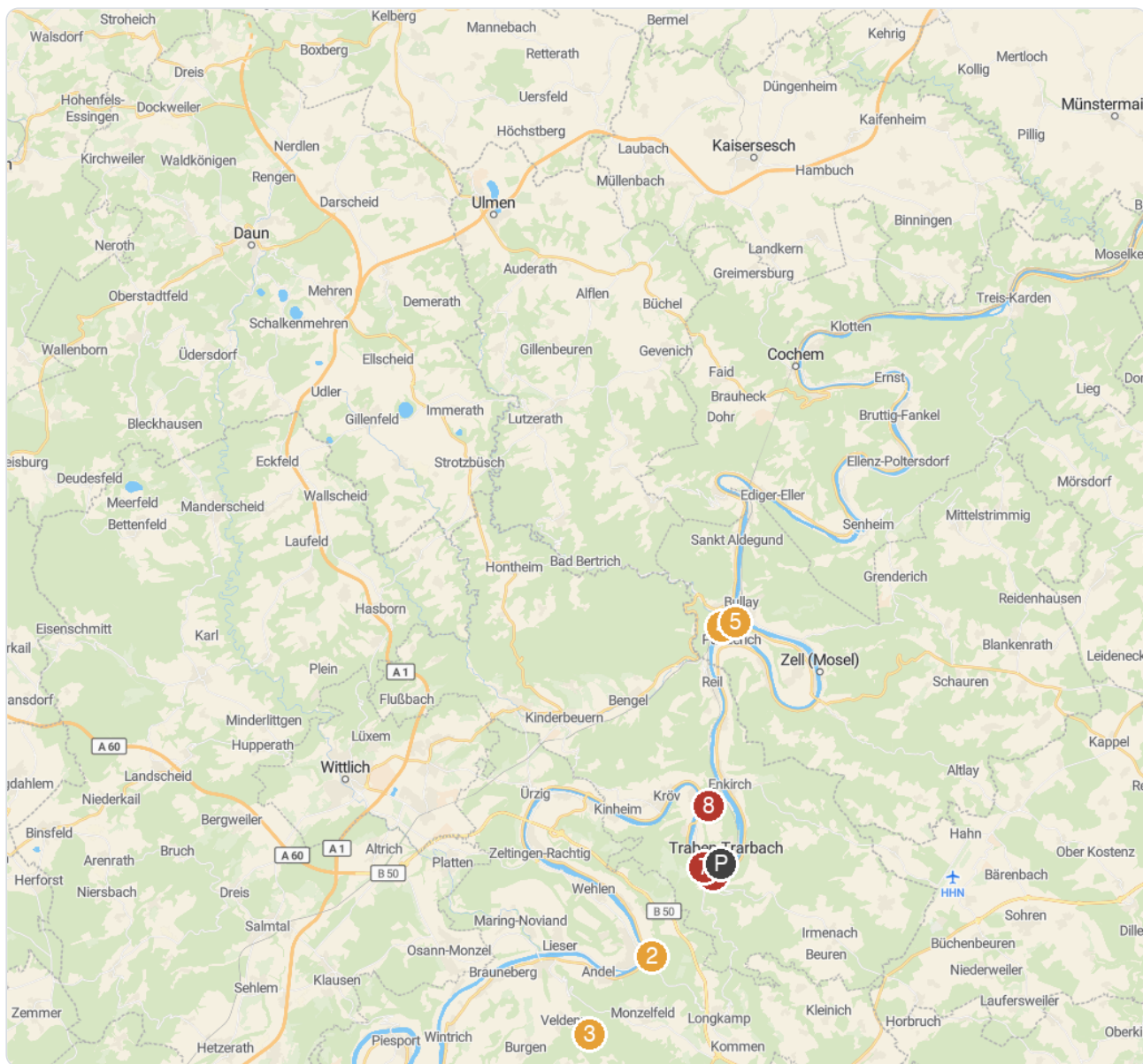
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
