GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Ostpreußenkai (central Travemünde) for small-mid ships; Skandinavienkai (industrial, shuttle needed) for large vessels

Walk to center: 0 min from Ostpreußenkai — promenade is right at the gangway; ~20 km to Lübeck (20 min by train)

Best For: History buffs, beach lovers, foodies, architecture fans

Don't Miss: Café Niederegger marzipan in Lübeck; Holstentor Gate; fresh Fischbrötchen at the fish harbor

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Lübeck Old Town Walking Tour** — Explore the UNESCO World Heritage city — the Holstentor gate, St.
- **European Hansemuseum** — The world's largest museum on the Hanseatic League — immersive, modern, and genuinely fascinating.
- **Travemünde Beach Day** — Wide, fine-sand Baltic beach just a 15-minute walk from the cruise pier.
- **Museum Ship Passat** — The legendary 1911 four-masted steel barque moored on the Priwall peninsula — one of the last Flying P-Liners.
- **Fish Harbor & Fischbrötchen Lunch** — Travemünde's Fischereihafen (fishermen's harbor) is steps from the pier.

BEST WALKS

- **Travemünde Harbor Promenade & Beach Walk** 2.5 km · 30-40 min · Easy · Flat — From the cruise pier, stroll the Vorderreihe promenade past cafes and historic buildings, stop at the Fischereihafen for a...
- **Lübeck Old Town Loop** 3 km · 1.5-2 hrs · Easy · Cobblestones — From Lübeck Hauptbahnhof walk over the Puppenbrücke to the Holstentor, along Holstenstraße to the Marktplatz, into St.

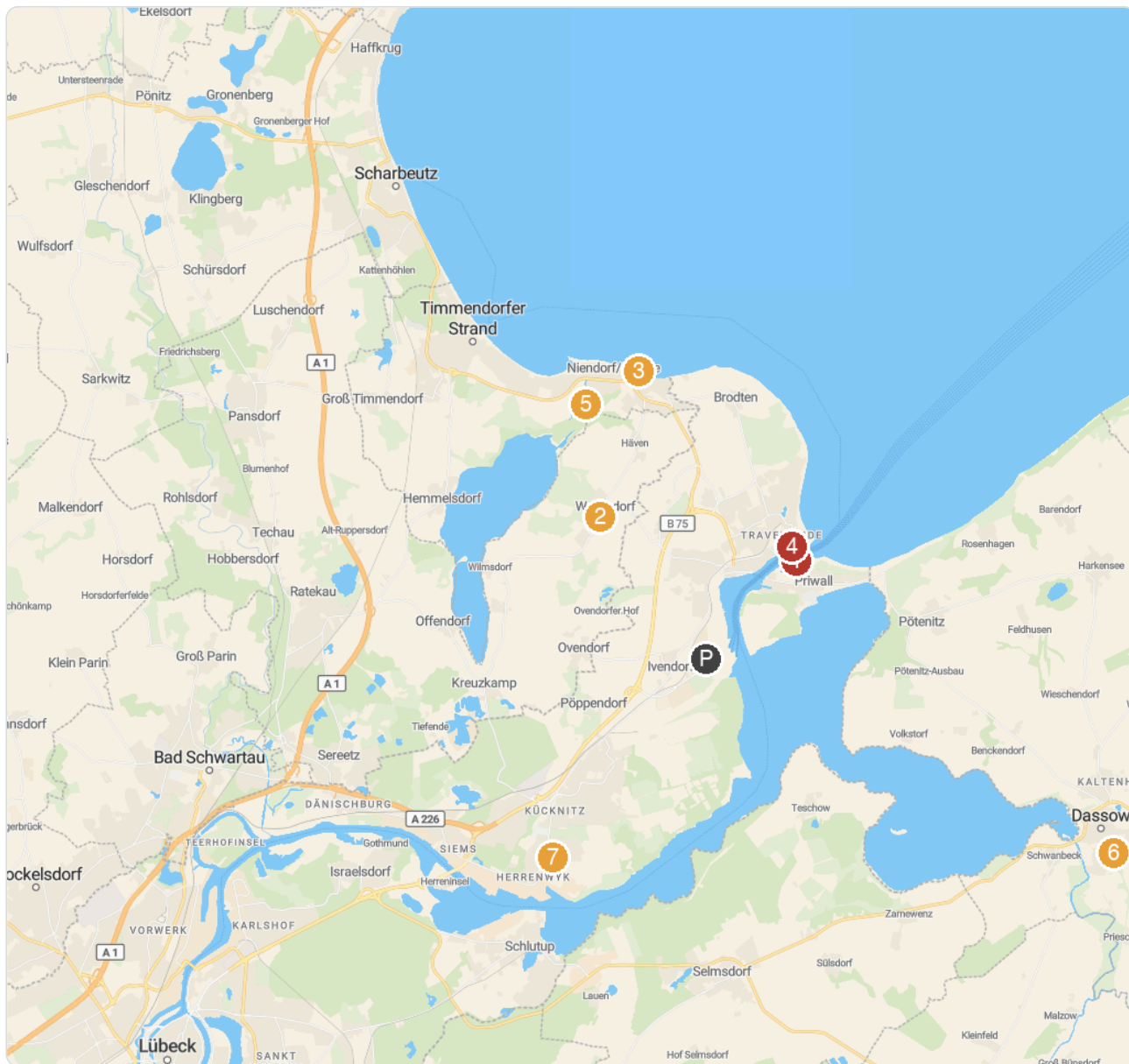
