- Gilded Age Downtown Walking Tour** — Troy's Victorian brownstones and cast-iron facades are so intact that HBO films The Gilded Age here.
  - Troy Savings Bank Music Hall** — Opened in 1875 and considered one of the finest concert halls in the world for acoustics.
  - Collar City Food Trail** — From Famous Lunch's legendary Zippy-sauce mini-dogs (since 1932) to Brown's Brewing
- Company on the river and the...

  - Burden Iron Works Museum** — The Romanesque Revival office building of Troy's once-mighty iron empire, home to the world's most powerful water wheel.
  - Oakwood Cemetery & Views** — This sweeping 19th-century cemetery is the resting place of Samuel Wilson — the real 'Uncle Sam' — and offers panoramic...

## BEST WALKS

- Riverfront to Monument Square Loop** 1.5 miles · 45-60 min · Easy — From the dock, walk east to Monument Square, then south along 2nd Street past the Victorian brownstones made famous by HBO's The...
- Waterfront Brewery Walk** 0.5 miles · 15 min · Easy — A short stroll north along the riverfront path from the dock to Brown's Brewing Company — a restored 19th-century warehouse with a...

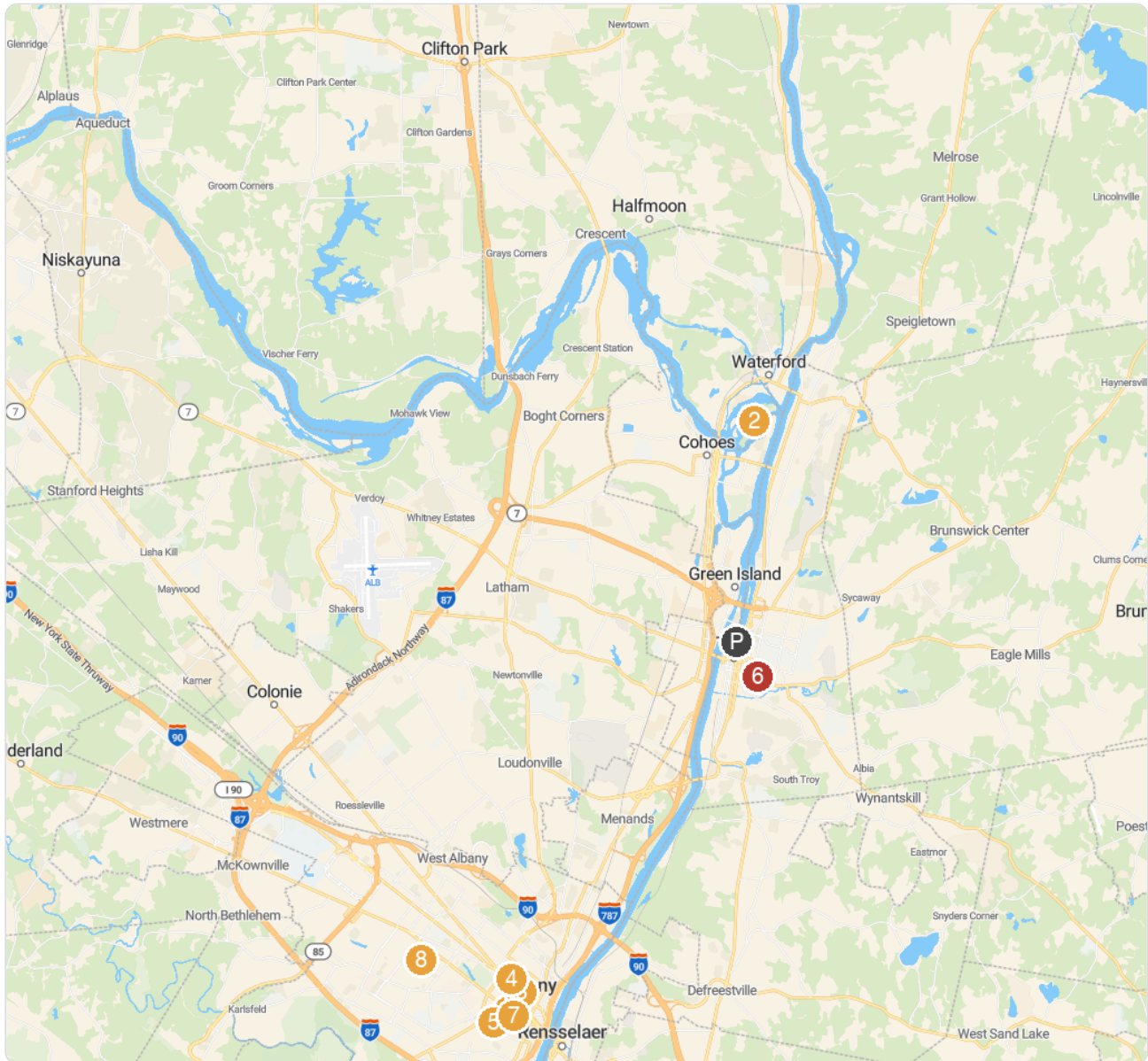
## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
