GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pier — ships dock directly, no tender required

Best For: Salamanca day trip, border scenery, Arribes del Duero nature

Walk to village: ~5 min to village centre; very small, limited services

Don't Miss: Salamanca's Plaza Mayor and University — a UNESCO WHS highlight

 Getting around: **Taxi** ~€100–€150 one-way (estimated, long-distance rate)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Salamanca — Golden City Day Trip** — Spain's most photogenic university city glows in warm sandstone.
- Arribes del Duero Natural Park** — The Douro carves a dramatic gorge — up to 400m deep — along the Spanish-Portuguese border.
- Castelo Rodrigo, Portugal** — Cross the border into Portugal to reach this perfectly preserved medieval walled village perched on a hilltop.
- Arribes del Duero Wine & Bodega Visit** — The Arribes del Duero DO produces characterful reds from Rufete and Juan García grapes, rarely found outside the region.
- Miranda do Douro, Portugal** — A charming border town with a ruined cathedral, a medieval castle, and the unique Mirandese language — one of only two...

BEST WALKS

- Village & Border Bridge Stroll** ~1 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat riverbank — A quick amble through the village to the international bridge that connects Spain and Portugal.
- Douro Gorge Viewpoint Walk** ~2 km · 40 min · Easy–Moderate · Riverside path — Follow the Douro upstream from the quay along a riverside path to reach a viewpoint overlooking the beginning of the Arribes gorge.

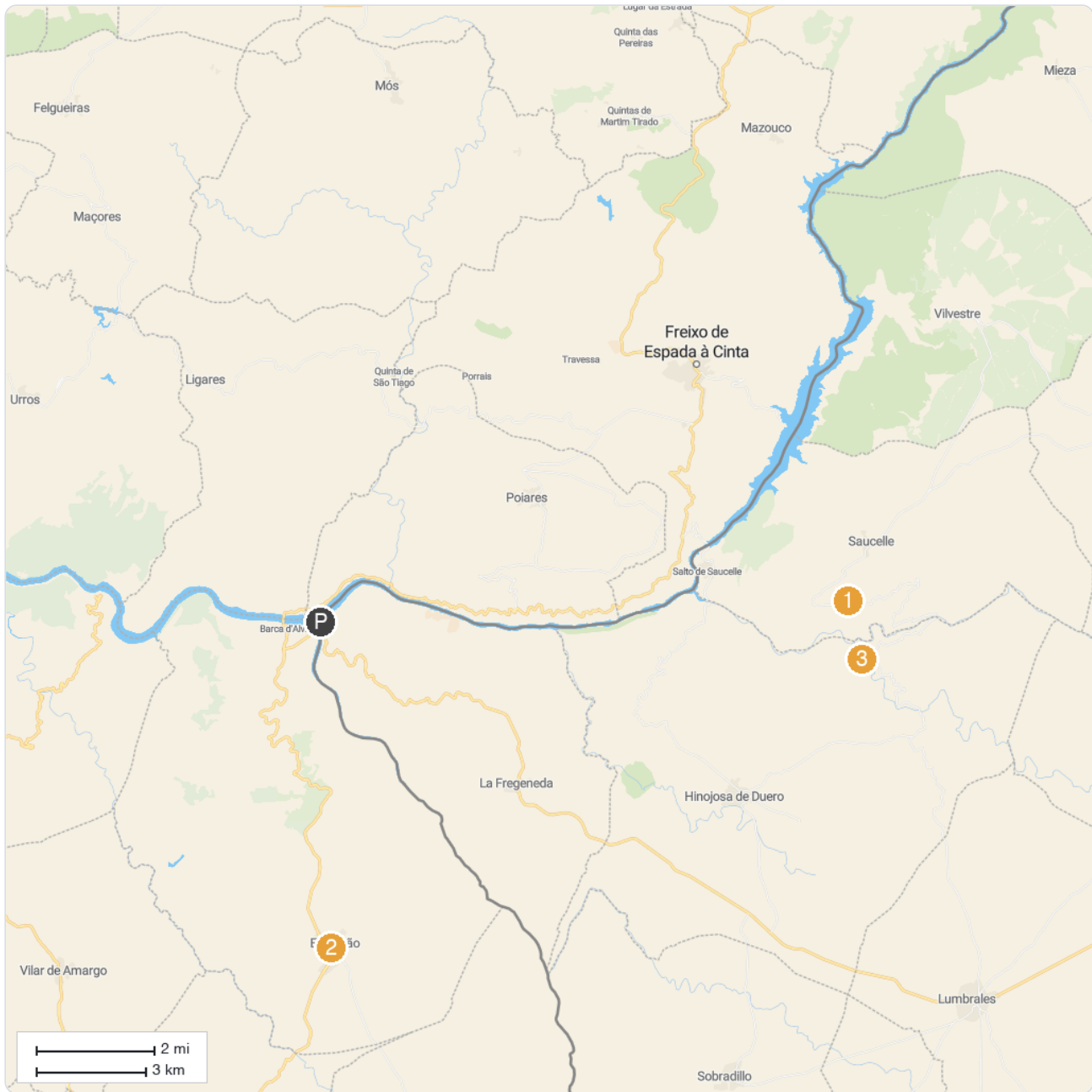
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Watch your timezone: Spain (CET) is one hour ahead of Portugal. Your ship may run on a different time — confirm all-aboard time carefully to avoid missing departure.
- Book Salamanca early: Coach capacity is limited and this is the most popular excursion. Book through your ship or a reputable
