TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Verona Arena** — One of the world's best-preserved Roman amphitheatres, built in 30 AD and still hosting world-class operas.
- **Old City Walking Tour** — Cover Piazza Bra, Piazza delle Erbe (the old Roman Forum), Piazza dei Signori, and the Scaligeri tombs.
- **Juliet's House & Romeo's House** — Enter Juliet's courtyard for free (timed entry in peak season), touch the bronze statue, and view the wall of love...
- **Castelvecchio & Ponte Scaligero** — A 14th-century red-brick castle housing a world-class art museum, and its stunning fortified bridge over the Adige River.
- **Lake Garda Day Trip** — Italy's largest lake is about 30 km from Verona — vivid blue water backed by mountains.

BEST WALKS

- **Arena to Ponte Pietra Loop** 2 km · 45–60 min · Easy · Free — Start at Piazza Bra and the Roman Arena, walk up Via Mazzini to Piazza delle Erbe, duck into Piazza dei Signori, find Juliet's House...
- **Castelvecchio & Riverside Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy · Free — From Piazza Bra head west along the Adige riverbank to Castelvecchio and cross the medieval Ponte Scaligero.

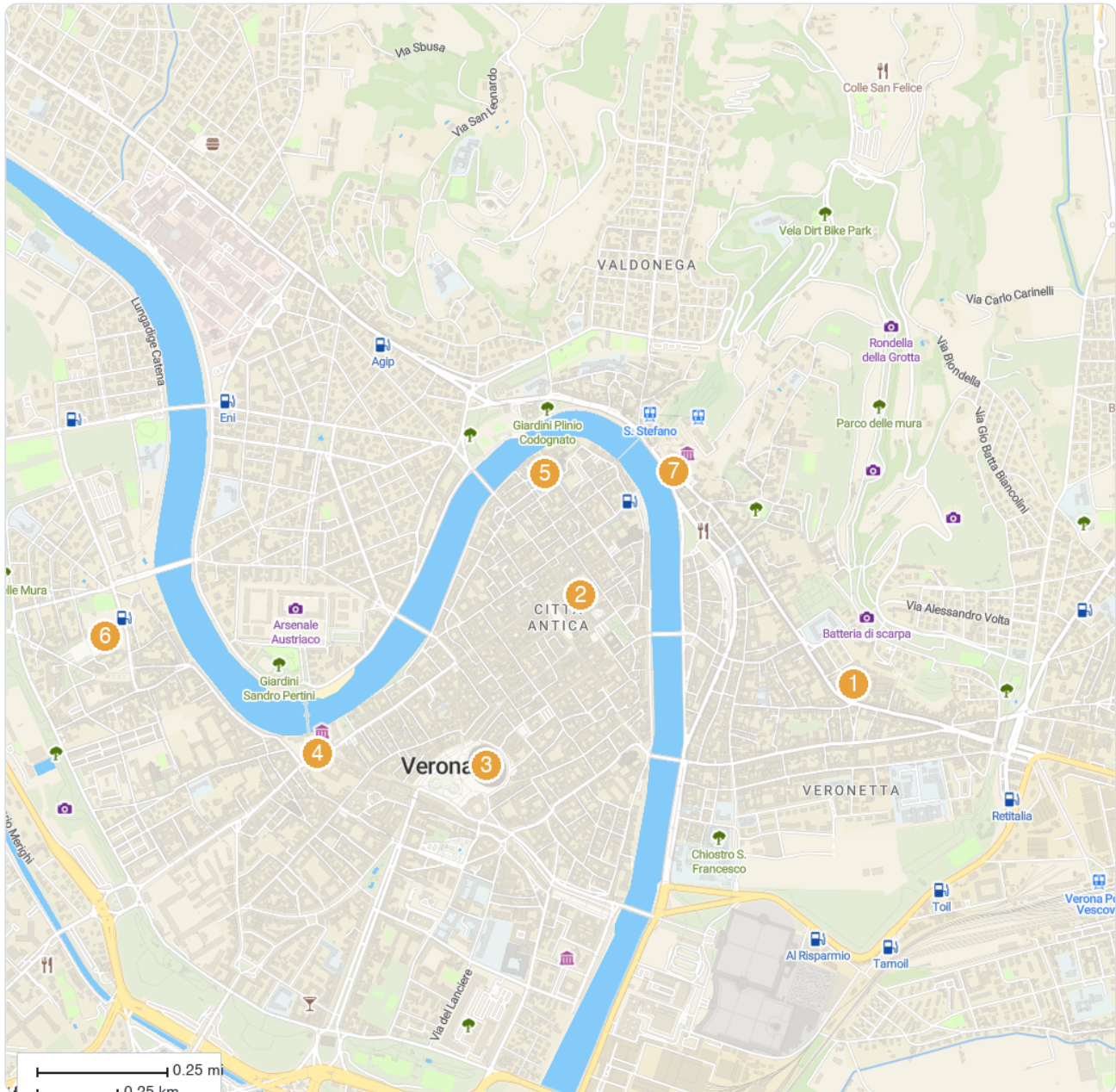
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
