Docking: Pier — Reichsbrücke/Handelskai (main) or Nussdorf; no tendering

Don't Miss: Schönbrunn Palace, Café Central, and standing-room opera tickets

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Schönbrunn Palace & Gardens** — The Habsburg summer residence and UNESCO World Heritage site.
- **Hofburg Palace & Sisi Museum** — The Habsburg winter palace in the heart of Vienna.
- **Ringstraße Walking Tour** — The 5 km imperial boulevard built by Emperor Franz Joseph rings the Innere Stadt.
- **Vienna State Opera Standing Room** — Experience the world-famous Staatsoper without paying hundreds of euros.
- **Coffee House & Naschmarkt** — Vienna's coffee house culture is UNESCO-listed intangible heritage.

BEST WALKS

- **Imperial Vienna: Cathedral to Ringstraße** 2 km · 1 hr · Flat · Free — Start at St.
- **Stadtpark & Belvedere Art Loop** 2.5 km · 1 hr · Flat · Paid entry at Belvedere — From Stadtpark (home to the golden Strauss statue), walk south along the Ringstraße to the Upper Belvedere palace.

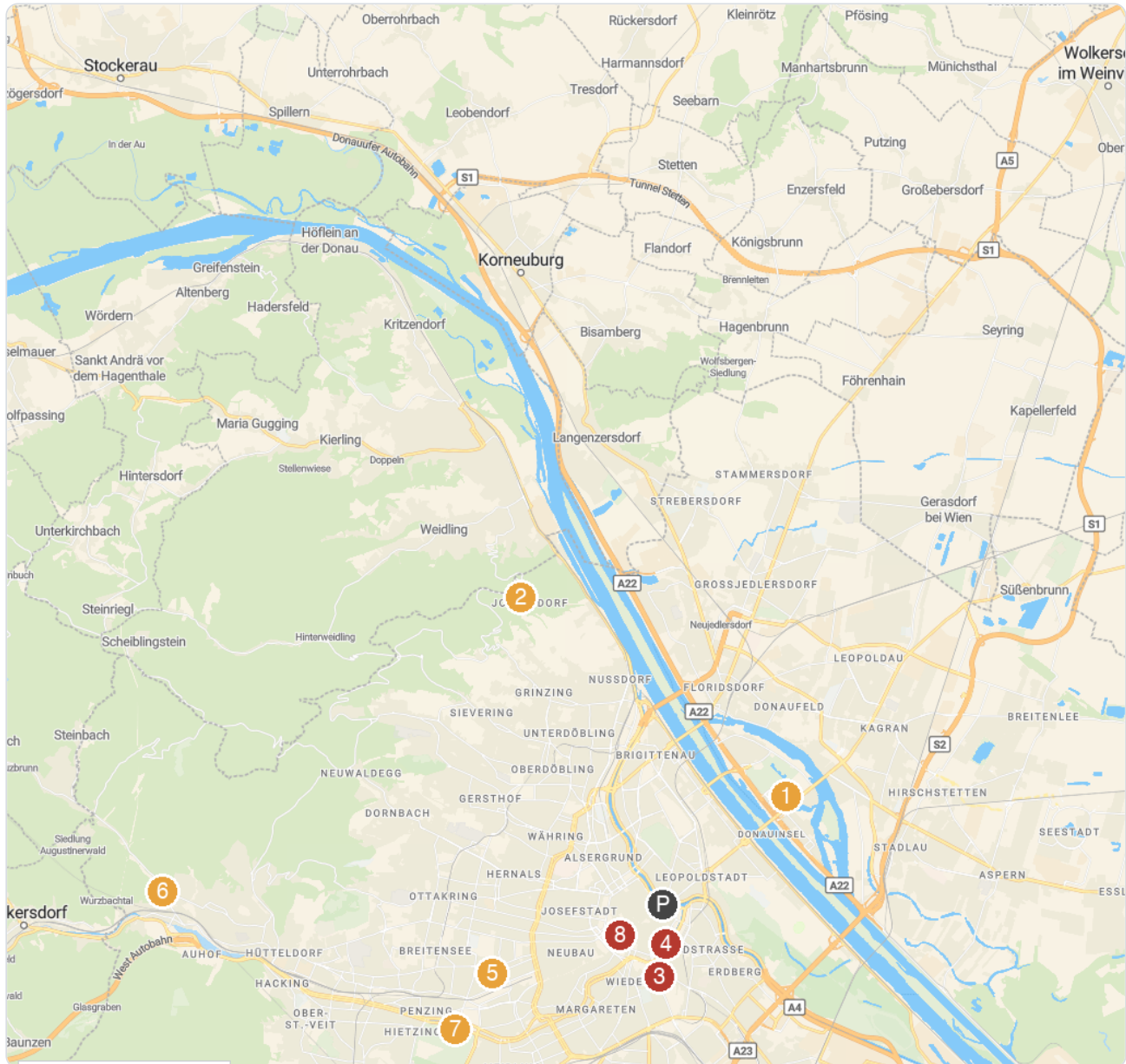
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy the 24-hour transit pass (≈€8) immediately at the U-Bahn machine — it covers all metro, tram, and bus. Validate it at the blue machine before your first ride. Inspectors do...
- Sundays close shops in Austria. Supermarkets, pharmacies, and most retail are shut. Restaurants, museums, and bakeries remain open — plan accordingly.
- Book Schönbrunn Palace online at least a week ahead. Walk-up time slots regularly sell out in summer. The gardens are always
