GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock directly at Visegrád Ship Station on the river — no tender required

Best For: Medieval history, panoramic Danube views, and easy walkable sightseeing

Walk to center: 10–15 min flat walk south along the riverfront to the Royal Palace area

Don't Miss: The Citadel's hilltop view of the Danube Bend — the most iconic viewpoint on the entire river

Getting around: **Taxi** ~1,400–1,800 HUF (~\$4–5 USD)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Visegrád Citadel** — The 13th-century fortress crowning the hilltop delivers 360° views over the Danube Bend — the most famous river...
- **Royal Palace of Matthias Corvinus** — Buried by a landslide in the 1700s and excavated in the 20th century, this reconstructed Renaissance palace features...
- **Alpine Bobsled Track** — A summer alpine coaster near the Citadel — unexpected fun for families and active cruisers.
- **Solomon's Tower & Medieval Knights** — A massive hexagonal 13th-century tower north of the pier, once used to imprison Vlad the Impaler.
- **Danube Bend Panorama Walk** — The flat riverfront promenade from the pier offers scenic views across the Danube to the Börzsöny Hills and the twin...

BEST WALKS

- **River Town Stroll** 1.5 km · Flat · 20 min · Free — Walk south along the Danube promenade from the ship station past Solomon's Tower, through the town center with its Baroque church, and...
- **Calvary Trail to the Citadel** 3 km · Steep · 50–60 min up · Hiking boots required — For fit hikers only — the Calvary Trail climbs 330 m through forested Pilis hillside to the Citadel.

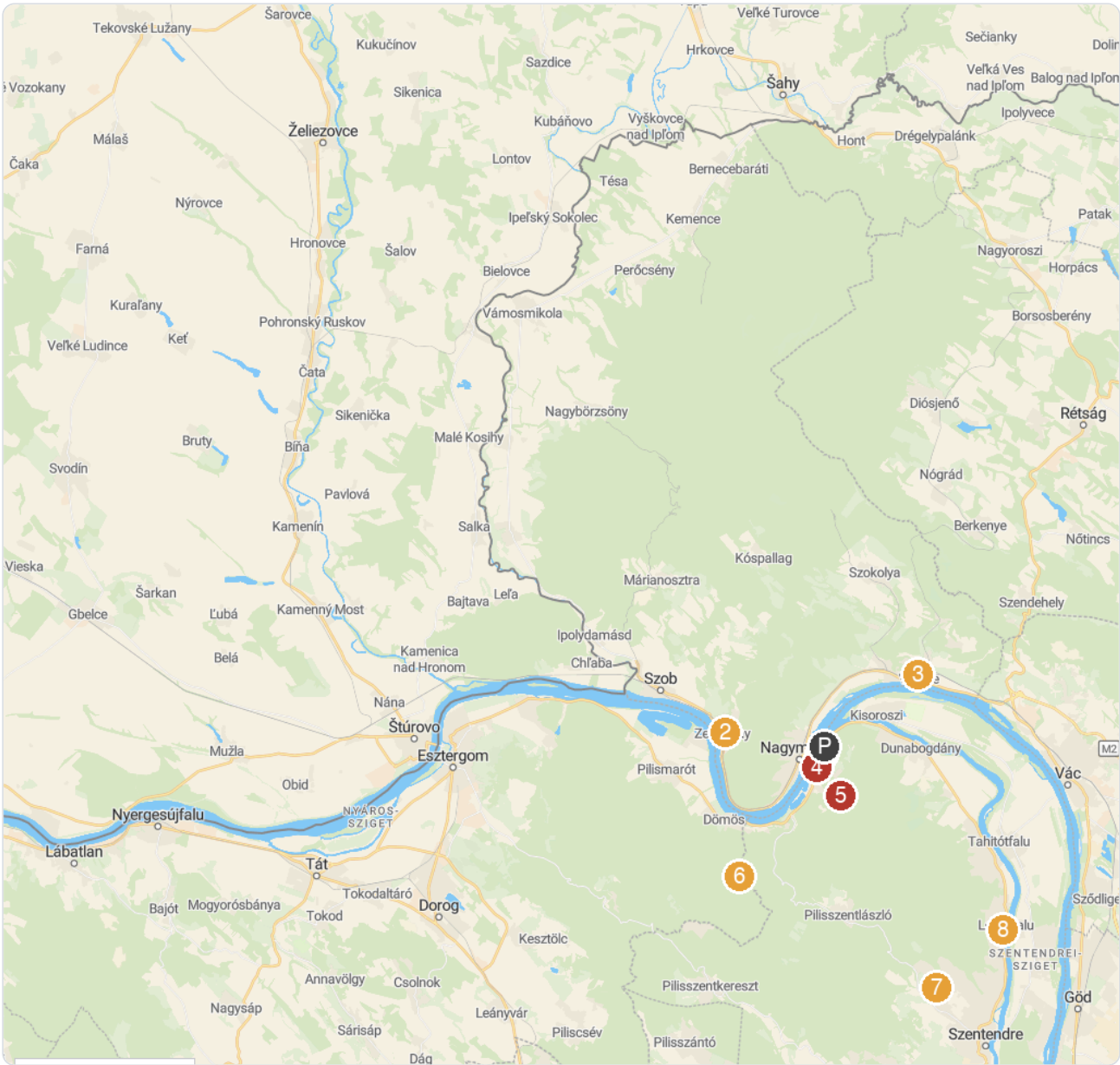
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
