GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — most cruise ships anchor in Carlingford Lough; smaller expedition vessels may berth at the harbour

Best For: Scenic drives, medieval Carlingford, Mourne Mountains hiking, Narnia connections

Walk to centre: 5 min from tender landing to Town Square

Don't Miss: Carlingford oysters, Kilbroney Forest Park, Narrow Water Castle

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kilbroney Forest Park & Cloughmore Stone** — Rostrevor's forest park, 3 miles from the port, holds the legendary 30-ton Cloughmore Stone and panoramic views over...
- Medieval Carlingford (Republic of Ireland)** — A 30-minute drive or ferry crossing away, Carlingford is one of Ireland's most intact medieval towns — cobblestone...
- Carlingford Lough Ferry Crossing** — Hop the roll-on/roll-off ferry from Greencastle to Greenore in 15 minutes — crossing an international border on the...
- Newry City Day Out** — Six miles away, Newry is one of Northern Ireland's oldest settlements.
- Warrenpoint Promenade & Town Walk** — The town's Edwardian promenade runs along the lough shore with mountain views across the water.

BEST WALKS

- Promenade & Edwardian Town Square** 1.5 km · Flat · 20-25 min — From the tender landing, follow the seafront promenade past the Municipal Park bandstand, then cut in to Warrenpoint Town Square — one...
- Narrow Water Castle Waterside Walk** 4 km return · Flat · 50-60 min — Head north along the Newry Road from the town centre to reach Narrow Water Castle, a photogenic 16th-century tower house sitting on...

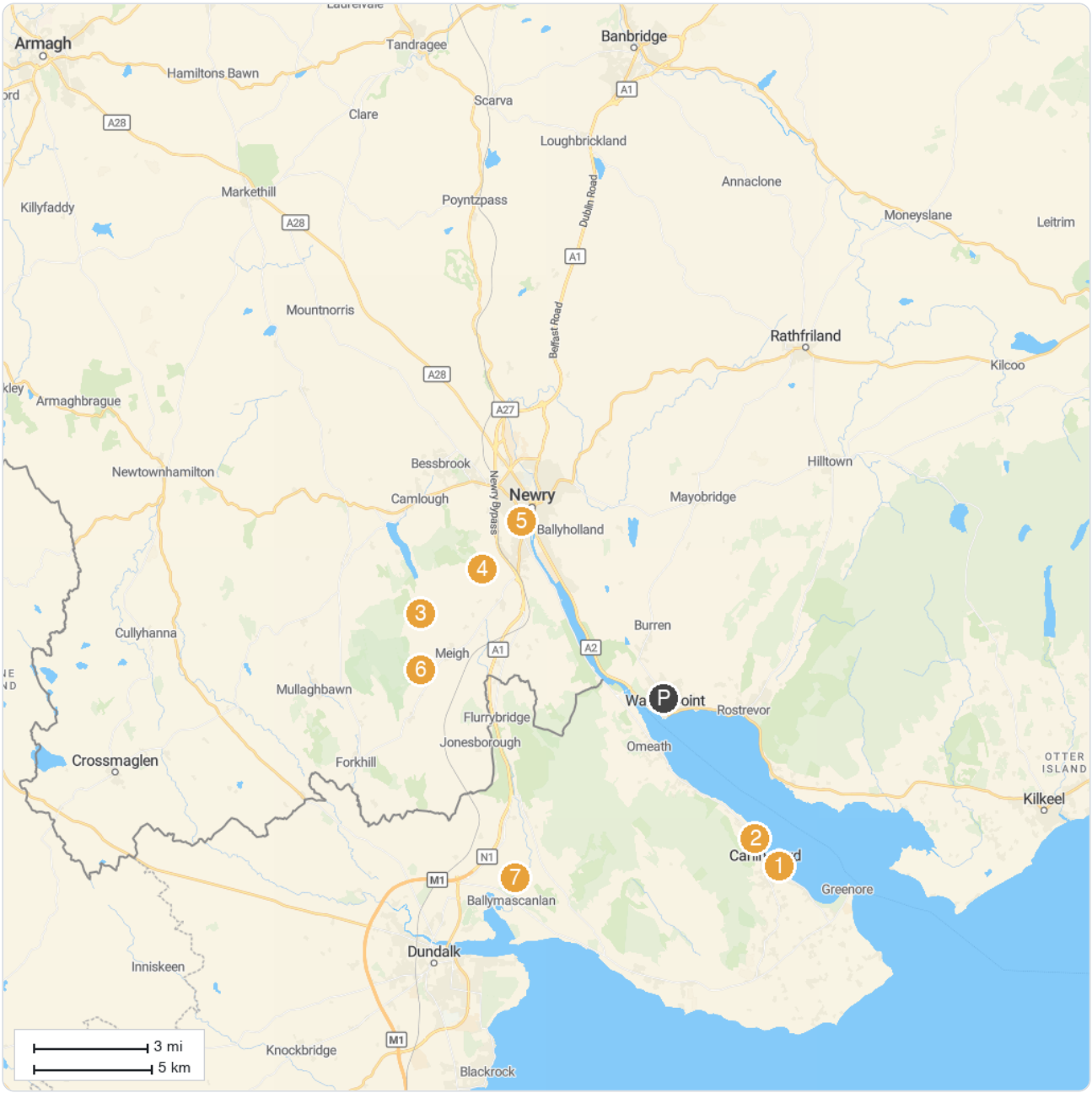
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
