GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River cruise ships dock alongside the Moselle quay — no tendering, direct step-off onto the promenade

Best For: Luxembourg City day-trippers, Moselle wine lovers, cycling along the river

Walk to center: 2–5 min to Grand-Rue; 8 min flat walk to train station

Don't Miss: Free train to Luxembourg City (UNESCO World Heritage) — no ticket needed anywhere in the country

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Luxembourg City — UNESCO Fortified Capital** — Hop the free train 35 minutes to one of Europe's most dramatic capitals.
- **Trier, Germany — Rome's Oldest City North of the Alps** — Cross the border by ferry or bus to Trier, home to the Porta Nigra, Imperial Baths, and a Roman amphitheater.
- **Moselle Cycling — Vineyards & River Trails** — Many river ships provide bikes.
- **Moselle Wine Tasting** — The Luxembourg Moselle produces excellent Riesling, Pinot Gris, and Crémant de Luxembourg sparkling wine at prices well...
- **Mullerthal Trail — Luxembourg's 'Little Switzerland'** — A short drive or bus ride opens up the Mullerthal region: dramatic sandstone rock formations, mossy gorges, and marked...

BEST WALKS

- **Moselle Confluence Promenade** 1–2 km · 20–30 min · Flat · Free — Walk south along the Moselle esplanade from your ship to the Spatz confluence park, where the Sauer River joins the Moselle.
- **Town to Train Station** 600 m · 8–10 min · Flat · Onward to Luxembourg City — A simple flat walk from the quay through the town center to Wasserbillig train station.

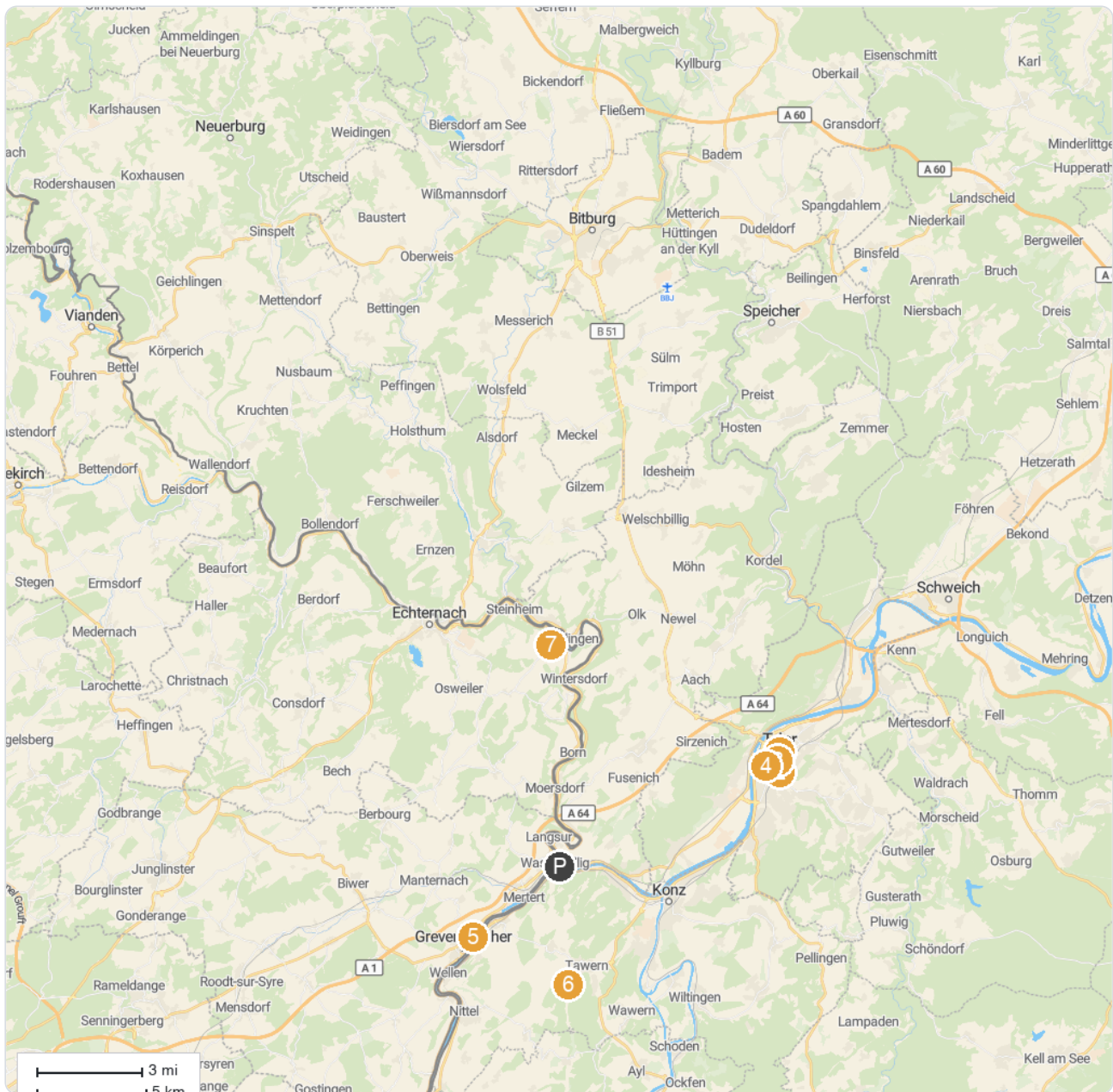
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
