

Wertheim am Main, Baden-Württemberg, Germany

One of the Main River's most photogenic stops, Wertheim am Main has been spared by centuries of conflict — its 16th-century market square, leaning half-timbered houses, and hilltop castle ruins look much as they did 500 years ago.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pontoon along Mainvorland promenade — no tender

Walk to center: 2–5 min to Maintor gate; 5–7 min to Marktplatz

Best For: Medieval architecture, castle views, wine tasting

Don't Miss: Burg Wertheim ruins and the Tauber–Main confluence

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €4.50–€8 (short hops)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Burg Wertheim Castle Ruins** — One of southern Germany's largest stone castle ruins, dating to the 12th century.
- **Glassmuseum Wertheim** — Three thousand years of glassmaking history, from Roman vessels to precision laboratory glass, with live glassblowing...
- **Franconian Wine Tasting** — This is the northern edge of Franconia's wine region.
- **Marktplatz & Old Town Walk** — Stroll the 16th-century market square anchored by the red-sandstone Engelsbrunnen (1574), admire the Zobel'sche Haus...
- **Tauber–Main Confluence (Spitze)** — A short flat walk to the peninsula tip where the muddy Tauber flows visibly into the green Main.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Castle Loop** 2–3 hrs · Moderate (steep castle climb) — From the pier, enter through the Maintor gate, cross the Marktplatz, visit the Stiftskirche and Zobel'sche Haus, then climb to Burg...
- **Confluence Promenade** 45 min · Easy, flat — Head downriver along the promenade to the Spitze peninsula where the Tauber meets the Main.

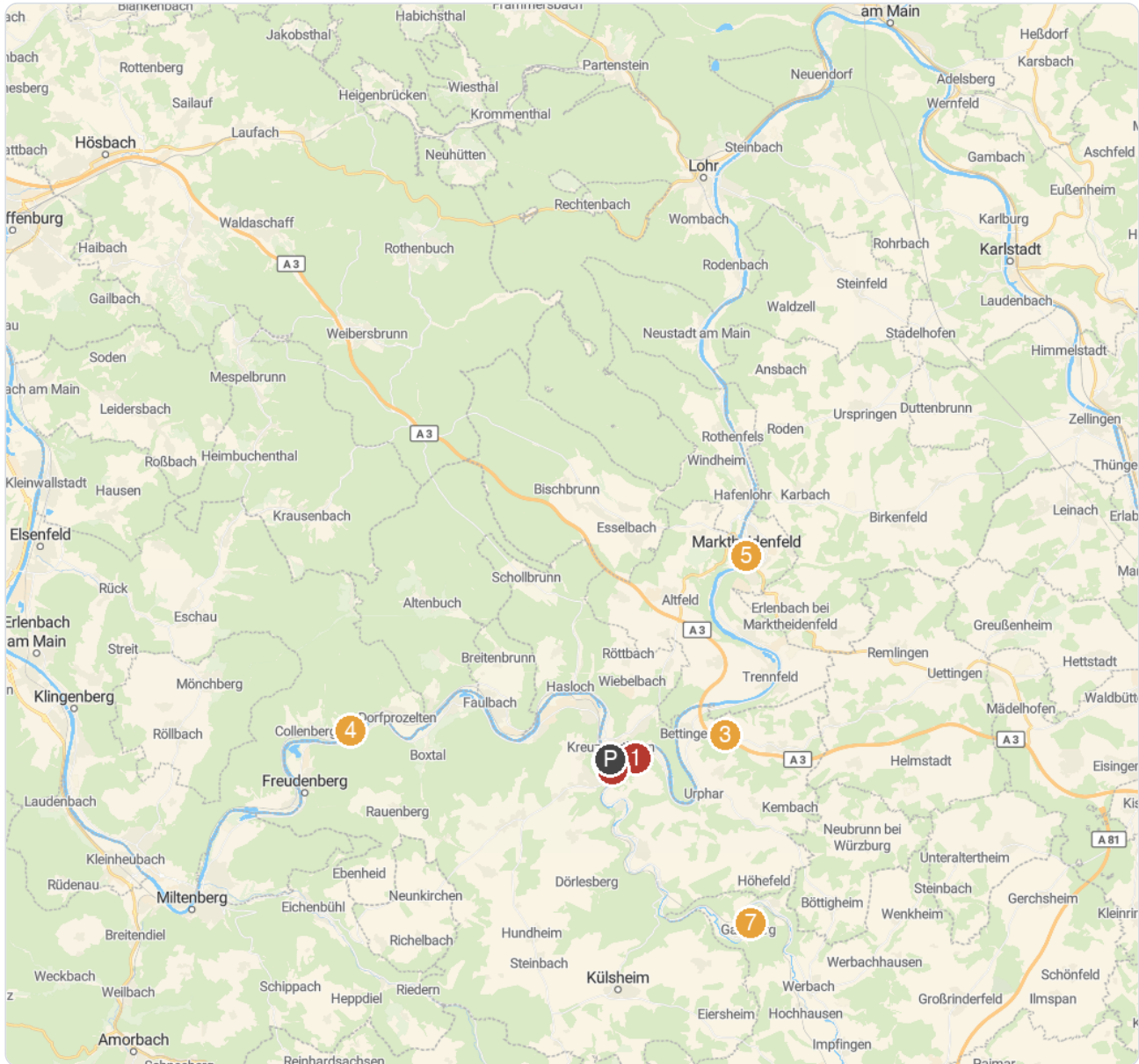
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Bakeries, the castle turnstile, and smaller cafes often don't accept cards. Keep a few €1, €2 coins for public restrooms.
