GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Lobster Rock Marine Terminal or Old Government Wharf; anchorage/tender also used

Best For: Maritime history, Acadian culture, fresh lobster, lighthouse scenery

Walk to center: 5–10 min from pier to Main Street; flat to slight uphill

Don't Miss: Cape Forchu Lighthouse (applecore shape) and Rudder's brew pub on the waterfront

Getting around:  Taxi  CAD \$11–14

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Cape Forchu Lighthouse & Leif Erikson Park** — One of the world's only 'applecore' lighthouses crowns a rugged headland 15 min from the pier.
- Yarmouth County Museum & Archives** — Inside a striking Gothic Revival church, 20,000+ artifacts span Mi'kmaq heritage, the age of sail, and the Acadian...
- Fresh Lobster & Acadian Cuisine** — Yarmouth sits at the heart of Canada's most productive lobster fishery.
- Working Lobster Boat Tour — Tusket Islands** — Board a real working lobster boat and haul traps with local fishermen.
- Victorian Heritage Walking Tour** — Yarmouth boasts the largest collection of standing Victorian homes in Atlantic Canada, built by wealthy 19th-century...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront & Heritage Core** 1.5 km · 25-30 min · Easy — Stroll from the pier along Water Street past Rudder's Brew Pub and the W.
- Victorian Captains' District** 2 km · 35-40 min · Easy-moderate (slight hills) — From Main Street, head along Collins Street and Albert Street to admire the grand 19th-century sea captains' mansions.
