GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Zingster Strom (Bodden/lagoon side of town) **Walk to beach:** 15–20 min on flat pedestrian street
Best For: Beach walks, cycling the national park, wildlife (cranes in autumn) **Don't Miss:** Seebrücke pier's Tauchgondel diving gondola and a Fischbrötchen at the harbour

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cycle the Vorpommersche Boddenlandschaft National Park** — Rent a bike and pedal into one of Germany's most scenic national parks.
- **Seebrücke Pier & Tauchgondel** — Walk 270 metres over the Baltic on Zingst's iconic wooden pier, then descend in the Tauchgondel — a steel gondola that...
- **Crane Migration Spectacle (Autumn)** — Each September–November, tens of thousands of migrating cranes rest on the Bodden wetlands around Zingst — one of...
- **Photography Art Trail** — Zingst has branded itself Germany's photography town.
- **Heimatismuseum Zingst** — This captain's house from 1867 tells the story of Zingst's fishing and shipbuilding heritage, with traditional...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbour to Baltic Pier** 1.2 km | 15–20 min | Flat | Paved — The classic Zingst stroll: start at the harbour on the Bodden side, walk Strandstraße past thatched cottages and boutiques, cross the...
- **Dune Promenade Walk** 2–3 km | 30–45 min | Easy | Sea views — From the base of the Seebrücke, follow the paved promenade along the top of the dunes east or west.

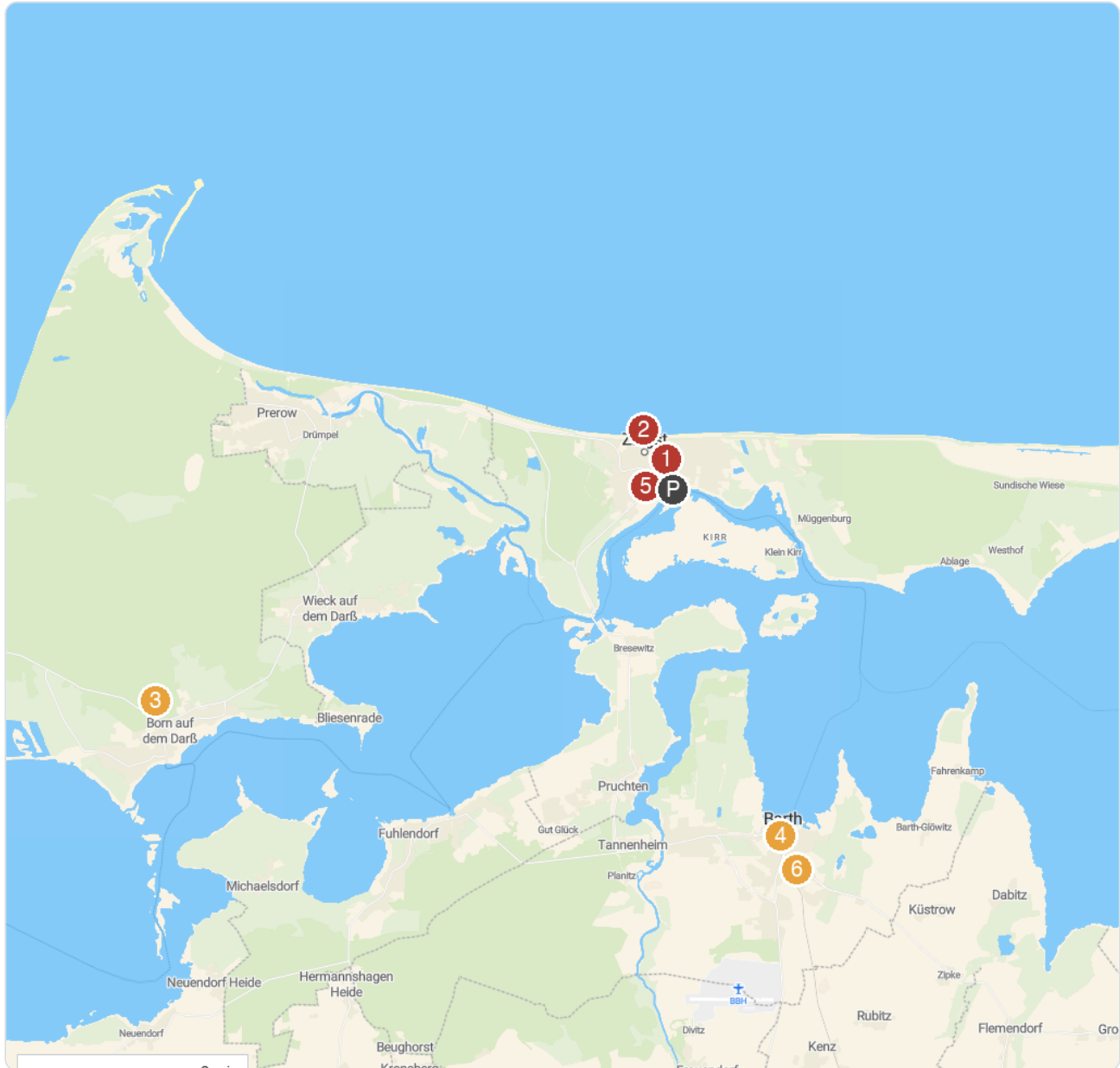
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Smaller bakeries, ice cream stands, Strandkorb rentals, and some bike shops in Zingst are cash-only. ATMs are available in town but can be busy when ships are in.
- Rent a bike early. Two wheelers are the best way to explore the national park. Several rental shops cluster near the harbour.
